Dear Parent:

Childhood diseases such as measles can spread quickly between children. That is why children must be protected by immunizations to go to school or childcare in California. A number of immunizations are required by law. Now is the time to make sure your child has received all of them.

#### WHAT YOU NEED

At registration you will need an Immunization Record showing the date your child received each of the required immunizations. If you do not have a record, contact your doctor or clinic now.

#### REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS FOR CHILD CARE ENTRY

Check your child's immunization record against the required immunizations shown below for children ages 18 months through 4 years.

<b>POLIO</b>	<b>3 doses</b>
<b>DTP</b>	<b>4 doses</b>
<b>MMR</b>	<b>1 dose given on or after the FIRST birthday</b>
<b>HIB</b>	<b>1 dose given on or after the FIRST birthday</b>
<b>HEPATITIS B</b>	<b>3 doses</b>

**MANTOUX TB TEST (bubble under the skin) WITH TEST RESULTS TAKEN NOT MORE THAN ONE YEAR PRIOR TO ENTRY.**

The State requires Woodcrest to have the above immunizations and TB test documented and in our files prior to the entry of your child into pre-school. Your child's registration will not be considered to be complete until all the above requirements are met.
