Dear Parent:

*The California Child Health and Disability Prevention (CHDP) Program law states that all children are required to receive a health examination within 18 months prior to entering first grade. For those children entering first grade in September, 2016, the required health examination must have taken place AFTER MARCH 1, 2015.*

*The examination should be done by your usual source of medical care. This includes a history and physical examination; developmental and nutritional assessment; necessary immunizations; tests for anemia and urine problems; tuberculosis skin test; and vision, hearing and dental screening.*

*The examination is intended to find any problems and arrange for early care if needed. One out of every 10 children entering first grade has a health problem unknown to parents. If children have a yearly medical check-up, many serious problems can be found and treated sooner, thus preventing health problems from causing permanent damage and saving medical costs to their families.*

*The attached health examination form must be completed and signed by your doctor and brought back to our school. We are required to look at the date of the physical examination to be sure it was TAKEN WITHIN 18 MONTHS PRIOR TO ENTRY into first grade and NOT the date the form was completed by the doctor.*

*Thank you for your cooperation in this matter. Registration of your child will not be considered to be complete until documentation of the completed physical examination is in your child's file.*
