(Amendment to Handbook)

FIRST OFFENSE

- Verbal warning from teacher to student
- Teacher will document incident and date in notebook supplied by Principal

SECOND OFFENSE

- Pink slip going home with student to parent, and parent's signature will be required before the child can return to school (No trivial matters)
- Teacher must document
- Mandatory Parent/Teacher Conference

THIRD OFFENSE

- Pink slip going home with student to parent, and parent's signature will be required before the child can return to school (No trivial matters)
- Teacher must document
- A mandatory conference must be set up with Student, Parent, Teacher and Principal before student returns to class

FOURTH OFFENSE

- Pink slip going home with student to parent, and parent's signature will be required before the child can return to school (No trivial matters)
- A second mandatory conference must be set up with Student, Parent, Teacher and Principal
- Suspension (the number of days will be determined by the severity of the case and by the Principal)

OR

• Expulsion when behavior has not been corrected

IMPORTANT

- If the above-mentioned policies are not adhered to, your child will not be allowed in the classroom.
- Violation of uniform policy will lead to discipline policy.

- Sexual misconduct <u>will not</u> be tolerated by students, or parents, or teachers.
- Tardiness 3 tardies within one quarter will result in 1 absence, and a pink slip will be sent home with student and a conference set-up with parent, student, and Principal.

REASONS FOR EXPULSION

- Possession of weapons, such as guns, knives, explosives, or other dangerous objects at school or any school related activity.
- Possession of drugs/drug paraphernalia; use or under the influence; unlawfully offer, arrange, or negotiate to sell at school or any school related activity.
- Commit robbery or extortion.
- Vandalism/Graffiti, damage to school property or other person's property; attempt to cause damage or caused minor damage.
- Obscenity, commit an obscene act; engage in vulgarity, either verbally or written.
- Sexual harassment, unwanted or inappropriate behavior towards another person be it physical or verbal.
- A continual violation of any of the above areas.
